Transportation in Nanjing

Nanjing Lukou International Airport is located in the northeast of Nanjing City, and 35.8 kilometers / 35 minutes away from the downtown area.

1) Airport Shuttle Buses

The buses going in to the city stop just outside level 1 of the airport.

From Nanjing Lukou Airport to Downtown Nanjing

Route A: Nanjing Lukou Airport --- Yuhua Square (雨花广场), Zhonghuamen Long-Distance Bus Station (中华门长途汽车站), Shuiximen (水西门), Hanzhongmen (汉中门), Caochangmen (草场门) and finally Shanghai Road (上海路).

(Operating time: before 19:00)

Route B: Nanjing Lukou Airport --- Yuhua Yuhua Square (雨花广场), Jinyu Hotel (金宇饭店), Shuiximen (水西门), Hanzhongmen (汉中门), Caochangmen (草场门) and finally Shanghai Road (上海路).

(Operating time: after 19:00)

2) Taxis Stop

Taxis stop on the first floor of the airport. A taxi fare from the airport to the city center should cost about RMB 135.

Taxis cost RMB 8 for the first 3 kilometers and RMB 2.4 for every additional kilometer. Starting in mid-June 2006 there is also an additional hidden RMB 1 fee because of high gas prices which takes the minimum prices up to RMB9.

An idea of the costs to get around Nanjing would be about RMB 9-12 to get from **Xinjiekou** to **Hunan Road** and RMB 9 to get from **Xinjiekou** to **Nanjing University**. Getting to **Purple Mountain** may cost RMB 20 from **Xinjiekou** or RMB 30 from **Hunan Road**.

Taxi drivers do not speak English, and most of them do not speak standard Mandarin either. They speak Nanjingese (Nanjinghua). Generally speaking, drivers are quite familiar with the city. Every taxi driver should know the most popular areas, and they will likely know the central areas in enough detail that they can navigate their way in and out of the alleys between major roads.

There have been some reports that taxi drivers sometimes pass off fake bills as change. For more safer, be sure to carry bills that are RMB 20 or under.

3) From the Nanjing Lukou International Airport to Jiu Long Hu Hotel

- Route A of Airport Shuttle Bus
- Drop off at Yuhua Square (雨花广场)
- Walk to Yu Hua Tai Nan Men (雨花台南門)
- Interchange Bus No. 119
- Drop off at Wen Hau Ming Yuan (Ning Li Luxi) (文化名园宁溧路西)
- Walk to Jiu Long Hu Hotel (九龍湖賓館)

4) Airport Bus in downtown area

The airport bus from the downtown area of Nanjing to Nanjing Lukou International Airport located inside Zhonghuamen Coach Station, which is next to Zhonghuamen Subway Station. The airport bus departs every half an hour from 06:00 to 20:30.

5) Direct Bus among Provincial Cities

From Nanjing Lukou International Airport to Wuxi:

The bus leaves at 11:00am, 15:00pm and 17:30pm from the airport to No.88 of the station Square.

From Wuxi to Nanjing Lukou International Airport:

The bus leaves at 07:00am, 11:00am and 13:30pm from No.88 of the station Square to the airport.

Weather in Nanjing

Known as one of the "furnaces of China," Nanjing, situated in the Yangzi River valley, experiences hot and humid summers, with temperatures running well into the 30s ° Centigrade (90s ° F) between June and early September. Winters remain damp, making temperatures that occasionally dip below freezing feel colder. Spring and fall are the most pleasant times to visit, especially April and May and September and October, when temperatures require the occasional sweater or jacket after sunrise and in the early morning, but usually warm to perfect shirtsleeve weather by midday. June through August can be quite rainy, as it is part of the East Asia Monsoon weather system. Air quality suffers from automobiles and industry, often adding a thick haze to the humidity during days with little wind.
